Exodus 17:8-16

8 The **Amalekites** came and attacked the Israelites at Rephidim. **9** Moses said to Joshua, "Choose some of our men and go out to fight the Amalekites. Tomorrow I will stand on top of the hill with the **staff of God** in my hands."



- **The Amalekites:** Were descendants of Esau and were known for being very cruel and cheap fighters.



- **The Staff of God:** When God called Moses to lead the people of Israel out of Egypt He gave him a staff. This staff enabled Moses to tap into God's power and reminded the Israelites of God's presence and power.

10 So Joshua fought the Amalekites as Moses had ordered, and Moses, **Aaron and Hur** went to the top of the hill. **11** As long as Moses held up his hands, the Israelites were winning, but whenever he lowered his hands, the Amalekites were winning. **12** When Moses' **hands grew tired**, they took a stone and put it under him and he sat on it. Aaron and Hur held his hands up—one on one side, one on the other—so that his hands remained steady till sunset. **13** So Joshua overcame the Amalekite army with the sword.

- **Aaron and Hur:** Were two of Moses' closest friends that helped him lead the people of Israel.

- **Hands Grew Tired:** Moses' hands grew tired throughout the battle and needed his friends help to hold them up.

- Try to Live At Peace With Everyone:

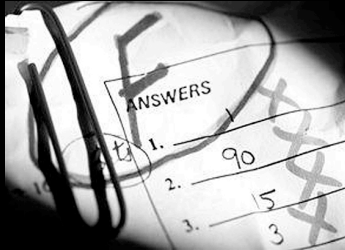
- “Make every effort to live at peace with all men.” -Heb. 12:14
